* Constantine moved the capital of the Roman Empire from Rome to an ancient Greek city "Byzantium"

Became New Rome – named after Constantine "Constantinople".

Massive Diffusion of Latin language and Christianity.

 Middle Ages begin 400's with fall of Western Roman Empire – last 1000 years

Western Roman Empire falls, and the Eastern Roman Empire thrives for 1000 years becoming the **Byzantine Empire**.

* Byzantine Empire – Christine Empire

Justinian Greatest Ruler of Byzantine Empire (Golden Age) - 500's rules, known for:

- 1) Justinian's Code organized & simpler code of laws
- 2) Hagia Sophia built by Justinian, a Christian Cathedral
- 3) Helped Women win more RIGHTS (with wife Theodora's help)

Goal; to restore the old Roman Empire by taking back the West, gaining much land back then the **Justinian Plague** hit, killing much of his army and he lost all that he had gained.

1453 – The Ottoman Empire, ruled by Sultan- Mehmed II (Mehmed the Conqueror) conquered Constantinople, and the Muslims will now control Constantinople and Name it, "Istanbul", Turkey.

The Hagia Sophia will be turned into a Mosque for Muslims.

Charlemagne

- Charles the Great- King of the Franks becomes "Charlemagne"- 1st person to unite most of Europe after the Fall of Roman Empire.
- Charles Martel "Charles the Hammer -his father known as the Mayor of the Palace- united with Pope's army run the Muslims off the Iberian Peninsula
- Charlemagne saves Pope from Germanic Tribe, Lombards crowns
 Charlemagne Emperor of Roman Empire on Christmas Day
- Middle Ages Carolingian Renaissance known to increase literacy rate (reading), writing, EDUCATION – SCHOOLS, so people could learn to read Bible
- Spread Christianity also forced conquered land to convert to Christianity

Japan

- Archipelago a chain of islands
- Shinto native religion, which includes Animism(nature spirits & Kami, Torri gates), Confucianism then (Buddhism from China-> Korea->Japan)
- China major influence on everything in Japan
- Prince Shotoku everything China, spreads Buddhism
- Heian Period Arts, poetry, literature, (Lady Murasaki Shilibu wrote 1 novel in world "Tale of Genji"
- Feudalism and Shogunate type of government
- Shogunate- is a military type rule where a
- weak emperor → Shogun (military general) rules → Daimyo (Lords) →
 → Samurai (Warriors/Knights) Bushido code (Chivalry) → peasants → serfs

Europe 1100s surplus goods, safer travel allows trade to resume in Europe

William Duke of Normandy → William the Conqueror (Normandy France, Viking descendent)

- 1066 won **Battle of Hastings** in England defeated English noble for English Throne *** **Norman Conquest**
- Claims ultimate authority over all feudal lands
- Doomsday book every person, all land, every animal- for \$\$ Taxes
- French now spoken in English Court → eventually merges w/English language = what we speak today

Henry II

- King of England/ Great Britain set up Central Royal Court
- King's law to all lands in kingdom with lawyers judges
- Created Common Law "same laws thru out kingdom"
- Set up juries of citizens, Grand Jury, (decide if u should be charged) and Trail Jury (decide if U are guilty or innocent)
- Sons King Richard The Lion heart and King John

Magna Carta-

- King John of England `1215 forced by English Nobles to sign Magna Carta (Great Charta)
- 1)Limits power of King, 2)Everyone has right jury trail 3) Rule of Law (same Laws for all) 4) everyone even King has to obey laws
- It is foundation of USA Constitution

Crusades – Holy War

- Begin after Muslim Seljuk Turks threaten Byzantine Empire
- 1st called by Urban!! reclaim Holy Land Jerusalem, & Save Byzantine
- 1st Christians won, 2nd Muslims won w/Saladin uniting Muslims 3rd- Muslims Sultan Saladin vs King Richard "the Lionheart" of England, Saladin / Muslims WON

Effects of Crusades

- Europeans exposed to Muslim ideas and discoveries increasing European want of education & thought
- Trade expanded & towns boomed
 LATE Middle Ages
 2 events weakened Feudalism 1) Crusades 2) The Black Death (the Plague)
 The Plague − Black Death- Bubonic Plague 1300's started in China →
 Europe , fleas on rats on trade routes like Silk Road, & ships 1 our of 2 died Effect : Wages rose- trade declined, decreased populations- helps end feudalism
